



Privacy Policy / Refund Policy

The RUSL Organization

The organization collecting the information.

The RUSL Clubs are the sole owner of the information collected on its sites and through other means. We will not sell, share, rent, or otherwise disclose this information to other parties other than as disclosed in this statement.

Please be aware that RUSL Websites contains links to other sites and that the RUSL Club is not responsible for the privacy policies of other sites. We encourage our users to take appropriate precautions when leaving our site and read the privacy statements of each and every web site that collects personally identifiable information. This privacy statement applies solely to information collected by this web site.

What personally identifiable information is collected from you through our web site and how is it used?

The RUSL Club collects membership information from our users at several different points throughout our web site and from other sources. This section describes these points of collection.

Membership Registration

In order to participate in any type of practice, including try-outs, an applicant must first complete a membership registration form. During registration an applicant is required to give contact information such as name, address, phone number, e-mail address, date of birth. This information is used to ensure the player is registered for the correct team and insurance purposes. All information is required unless otherwise stated on the membership form. This privacy policy governs both members who apply online or otherwise. Financial information is never shared inside or outside our organization, except as necessary to process membership for the team.

Other Collection Points

We may also collect information from people through other means such as the telephone, by e-mail, by fax, on paper, and in person. This privacy policy governs the use and disclosure of that information as well.

With whom may the information be shared and other kinds of disclosures.

We occasionally share information with lacrosse events in which the RUSL Club will participate. This section describes what information we share and with whom.

Sharing with non-Breakers Lacrosse Club third parties

When someone signs up for the one of the RUSL programs, we pass on the necessary information (name, address, age) to the event management personnel for each even the RUSL Club may participate. These parties are not allowed to use personally identifiable information except for the purpose of entering the person in the event. However, this information may be used to create programs, and results for the event which may include entrants' name, home city and state, age, etc. The RUSL Club has advised event management personnel that if they plan to use this information for purposes other than entering a person in the event, they must notify the RUSL Lacrosse Club.

We will also share information to prevent fraud, to respond to legal process, or otherwise as required by law.

Children

In cases where the RUSL Club collects personally identifiable information from children under the age of 18, we require parental consent before collection is completed. For example, the RUSL Club registration application requires a parent's or guardian's "signature" before it will be accepted. The signature on the application evidences the parent's or guardian's consent to have the child's information used as an aggregate collection. Individual information about children under 18 will not be shared; however information regarding their parents (name, address, e-mail, and phone) can be shared and are subject to this policy.

The kind of security procedures that are in place to protect the loss, misuse, or alteration of information under the RUSL Club's control.

RUSL Club takes every reasonable precaution to protect users' information: however Breakers Lacrosse club can not guarantee that your information is 100% secure.

When registration forms ask users to enter sensitive information (such as credit card number and/or social security number), that information is encrypted and is protected with industry-standard encryption software (SLL). While on a



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secure page, such as our registration application, the lock icon at the bottom of web browsers (i.e. Netscape Navigator, Microsoft Internet Explorer) appears locked. If not locked, any information a user submits is not secure, and the RUSL Club will not be responsible for the loss or theft of such information.

While we use SSL encryption to protect sensitive information online, we also make every reasonable effort to protect users' information off-line. Access to users' information, not only the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in our organization. Only those employees who need the information to perform their job are granted access to personally identifiable information. All employees are kept up-to-date on our security and privacy practices and are reminded about the importance we place on privacy.

The RUSL Club makes every reasonable effort to safeguard sensitive information by regularly reviewing our security standards and practices to protect against unauthorized access. Correction/Updating Personal Information

If a user's personally identifiable information changes (such as your address, phone, e-mail address, etc.), this can be changed by the user by contacting the RUSL Club.

Notification of Changes

If the RUSL Club changes its privacy policy, we will post a notice of the change on our homepage for at least seven days so users are always aware of what information we collect, how we use it, and under what circumstances, if any, we disclose it. If at any point the RUSL Club decides to use personally identifiable information in a manner different from that stated at the time it was collected, users will have a choice whether to opt-out from such use

REFUND POLICY

When a player registers for the RUSL Club he (his guardian) is responsible for all fees associated with accepting that position. All fees are expected in a timely manner as outlined at time of registration. All fees are considered non-refundable. Due to the nature and expenses of our preplanned (i.e. events, tournaments) RUSL has a policy of no refunds.

- Only medical conditions which prevent a player from complete participation in the current registered program may warrant a refund. A doctor's note must be submitted to your respective program director for case review.
- All information (including doctor's notes) must be submitted 30 days prior to the registered programs first scheduled day for a full refund (less any deposit fee, and uniform expenses).
- Information submitted 15 days prior to the registered programs first scheduled day, 50% of the program fee will be refunded (less any deposit fee, and uniform expenses).
- Any requests submitted after the 15 day policy will not be reviewed.
