Parent Code of Ethics and Conduct

As a parent/guardian in this athletic program, I will:

- Know and abide by the philosophy and rules of CYO, the Holy Trinity Athletic Association, and the coaches,
- Accept responsibility for timely fee payment and completion of all registration and physical forms associated with the program,
- Attend all parent meetings as requested by the athletic director, sports commissioners, and/or coaches, and
- Properly maintain and return issued uniforms and equipment at the end of the season (or pay a replacement fee in the amount set by the sports commissioner and athletic director).

I understand that my role as a parent/guardian is to provide encouragement and emotional support regardless of winning or losing while modeling Catholic behavior and values.

I understand that the role of the coaching staff is to instruct, guide, and teach sport strategies, skills, and Catholic values. I will respect the role of the coaching staff and will not interfere, whether during practices or games. In the event that a problem or issue arises, I will address it with the coach in private and away from others. If the problem or issue cannot be resolved through discussion with the coach, I know that the sports commissioner and/or athletic director will be brought in to help mediate a solution.

I understand that inappropriate conduct, profane/vulgar/abusive language, or disrespect toward coaches, athletes, officials, site personnel, and others involved in CYO athletics will not be tolerated.

Finally, and perhaps most importantly, I understand that the core purpose of this program is to empower young people to live as disciples of Jesus Christ in our world today; draw young people to responsible participation in the life, mission, and work of the Catholic faith community; and foster the total personal and spiritual growth of each young person.
