



## Get Your Helmet Game Ready



The West Jefferson Youth Athletic Association Inc., (“WJYAA”) would like to give our community the opportunity to have their personal football helmets reconditioned and recertified for the upcoming season at a reduced cost. If you were to send your helmet to a company it could cost you \$100 or more to have it recertified and painted. We are able to cut the cost to \$45 dollars by organizing a group rate.

If any participant, player or parent have already purchased your own helmet and are planning on having your child use it for the upcoming football season we strongly encourage you to take advantage of this opportunity to help keep your child safe and protected. It is possible for an older helmet to fail testing and not be recertified thus the helmet would not be able to be worn by your child. WJYAA reserves the right to deem a helmet unsafe. This will be your only opportunity for this huge savings this year.

**COST: \$45 (bring check or cash)**

**When: May 20th 12p-2pm: drop off helmet at Converse Park**

### Reasons to Recondition a Football Helmet

1. Safety-know that the helmet your child is wearing is in proper working condition.
2. NOCSAE Certified-peace of mind that the helmet is safe.
3. The helmet will be cleaned and sanitized.
4. The WJYAA could deem a personal helmet unacceptable for use if the helmet has not been recertified or is deemed unsafe by equipment manager or any WJYAA Executive Board Member.
5. The color of the helmet will match the new helmets purchased by the WJYAA. WJYAA may require all helmets match, so this is a great opportunity.
6. Its cheaper than buying new.

### 4 Steps to have a Reconditioned and Certified Helmet

1. Bring your helmet to Converse Park on May 20th from 12-2pm
2. The WJYAA will send it away for Inspection-the helmet will be evaluated by experts.
3. Reconditioning and Recertification-includes cleaning, sanitizing, painting (if needed), inspection, repairs and NOCSAE Certification.
4. Play-the helmet will be returned fully reconditioned, recertified and ready for the season.



The costs outlined above is in addition with the regular sport fees set by WJYAA. To ensure adequate safety for each player we reserve the right to prohibit a helmet that is not NOCSAE certified or the certification is unverified or more than a year old. WJYAA is not responsible for any lost helmets..
