Kings Youth Lacrosse Coaching Contract

As a representative of Kings Youth Lacrosse, you shall agree to abide by the following:

- 1. You will, at all times, present yourself in a proper, adult manner, as determined by fellow coaches, parents and players.
- 2. You will not use profanity.
- 3. You will at no time use alcohol or tobacco products on a practice or game field. Under no circumstances will you participate in a practice or game under the influence of alcohol or other substances. It is the responsibility of the head coach to police their staff.
- 4. You will leave a facility immediately if asked to do so by your head coach, an Executive Board member or official. You agree that any questions or grievances may be addressed at a later date.
- 5. You accept that it is within the rights of the Executive Board, at any time, to request the resignation of your participation in Kings Youth Lacrosse.
- 6. You understand that under no circumstances is a member of a Kings Youth Lacrosse coaching staff to attempt to treat a serious injury. Treatment shall be the responsibility of proper medical personnel.
- 7. You are responsible for the welfare of the players while they are within your supervision and exposed to potential liabilities of same.
- 8. You will receive the support of the Kings Youth Lacrosse's Executive Board at all times relevant.
- 9. You will, to the best of your abilities, teach the fundamentals of lacrosse and good sportsmanship to all members of your team.
- 10.You will attempt to maximize the participation of each player on your team in all practices and game.
- 11.You understand that the Kings Youth Lacrosse Executive Board places player fundamental skill development, good sportsmanship, and player participation above winning.
- 12.You accept that any violations of the above will be subject to review by the Board and may result in suspension or expulsion of coaching duties. Any

disagreements with the Board's decision may be appealed. All requests for appeal will be submitted in writing, to a member of the Board. The Board will set a date for review, at which time you may present your case, with any documentation or oral presentation you deem pertinent. Within one week the Board will render a decision to you in writing. All appellate decisions are final and not subject to further review.

13.Each Head Coach is responsible for the following at their home game(s):

- a. 2 coaches to be present at his entire home game.
- b. Enforcement of crowd control.
