2017-18 Prince & Princess Memorial Tournament Rules

1. **Administration:** The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress will administer this tournament.
2. **Cost:** \$30.00 per bowler.
 - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted subject to lane availability. **Walk-in entries will close at 10:30 am.** A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the day of the actual event bowled.
 - b. Payment must accompany entry form. Spots will not be held without full payment.
 - c. No refunds will be given once paid entry has been ACCEPTED by GDUSBC
3. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all youth and adult bowlers who hold a current USBC membership and are in good standing of the USBC.
4. **Averages:** Average used will be the highest average from the 2016-2017 bowl.com for 21 games OR a current average of 180 or lower in a league of 21 games or more as of April 1, 2018.
 - a. Falsifying of average may lead to the disqualification of the bowler, forfeiture of fees, and possible suspension.
 - b. USBC rules 319A, 319C, 319E and 322 are in effect and will be enforced.
 - c. All errors must be reported within 48 hours of competition. The GDUSBC phone number is 937-222-2695.
 - d. Tournament Chairperson reserves the right to re-rate bowler with a current average (21 games or more) that is 10 pins higher than 2016-2017 average.
5. **Tournament Play:**
 - a. Bowlers will bowl on Saturday, May 19, 2017 at 11:00 am.
 - b. Lane assignments/Prepaid Entries requesting to bowl together will be paired together if noted on the entry form.
 - i. Walk-in registration lane assignments will be random.
 - c. **ALL Bowlers will move 1 pair of lanes right after each game, with a one lane courtesy given.**
 - d. The tournament has a maximum of 16 lanes.
 - e. Any prepaid bowler arriving late shall receive zero for frames missed and shall begin play with the frame being bowled.
 - f. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within 15 minutes of the tournament conclusion
 - g. Lanes will be oiled before the squad on tournament day.
 - h. Substitutes will be permitted. Substitutes will receive all prize monies awarded and are not required to reimburse the original entrant for the entry fee paid. There will be NO refunds.
 - i. Decisions of the tournament committee are final.
 - j. Appeals may be made, in writing, to the GDUSBC within 72 hours of the tournament conclusion
6. **Entry Forms:** Entry form must be **COMPLETELY FILLED OUT & LEGIBLE**. Incomplete entry forms can lead to disqualification.
7. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee. Courtesy to other bowlers and tournament volunteers is expected and will be enforced. Loud, rude, or unsportsmanlike behavior as defined by Tournament Official will not be tolerated.
8. **AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS:** Scholarships/SMART money for youth and Cash for adults will be based on one out of every ten in each division.
9. **Dress Code:** All bowlers are expected to use good judgment and wear suitable attire during tournament play. Clothing choices must be presentable and non-offensive to other bowlers or spectators. Examples of prohibited attire include but are not limited to: any shorts that are more than 4 inches above the knee, pants hanging below the waist, display of underwear and/or body parts, hats, low-cut shirts, see-through clothing, T-shirts with alcohol or cigarette advertisements, inappropriate language, gestures, or gambling. Bowlers may be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by a GDUSBC Tournament Official. Tournament Official's decision will be final. Failure to comply with any dress code rule will result in a verbal warning and apparel change (if applicable). Second offense will result in offender being asked to leave the center for the day, disqualification from the tournament and forfeiture of any entry fees submitted.
10. **Conduct:** Tournament Officials may warn or disqualify bowlers for unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct. There will be a zero tolerance policy for foul language, rude gestures, or abuse of bowling center equipment. Tournament Officials and/or Bowling Center Management may remove any coach or spectator for disruptive conduct and if necessary, suspend them from attending future tournaments.
