2019 Annual Youth Leader Tournament Rules

1. **Administration:** The Greater Dayton United States Bowling Congress Youth Leaders will administer this tournament.
2. **Cost:** \$20.00 per bowler.
 - a. Walk-Ins will be accepted, subject to lane availability. Walk-in entries will be accepted up to **10:30 am**. A walk-in is defined as an entry being submitted the **day** the actual event is bowled.
 - b. Payment must accompany entry form. Spots will not be held without full payment.
3. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to youth bowlers who hold a current USBC Youth membership and are not active in High School Bowling.
4. **Participation:** High score including handicap will determine award winners.
5. **Handicap:** Handicap will be 90% of 215 (all divisions).
6. **Averages:** Average used will be the highest average from bowl.com for 21 games during the 2017-2018 season. If a bowler does not have an existing 2017-2018 average listed on bowl.com, he/she will enter the tournament as a scratch bowler with a 215 average (no handicap), unless the bowler is able to provide a current standing sheet from a 2018-2019 sanctioned youth league with an average comprised of at least 9 games.
7. **Re-rates:** If the league was a sport and/or challenger condition league, the average will be adjusted according to rule#201c.
8. **Format for the Tournament:**
 - a. This tournament will be conducted in four divisions: Bumpers, Bantam, Prep, and Junior.
 - b. All divisions will bowl three (3) games.
 - c. Winners will be determined by total pins including handicap.
 - d. Scoring errors: Scoring errors must be reported to the tournament office within 15 minutes of the completion of the shift.
 - e. Tardy Bowlers: Bowlers must start in the frame being bowled at the time they arrive in the tournament office. Bowlers will receive zero (0) pins for all frames missed. No absentee scores are permitted.
 - f. In case of ties, the highest score in the 3 game series will be used to break the tie.
9. **Entry Forms:** Entry form must be **COMPLETELY FILLED OUT & LEGIBLE**. Incomplete entry forms can lead to disqualification.
10. **Rules:** The tournament rules above and USBC rules will govern this tournament and will be strictly enforced. All rules not covered above will be determined by the tournament committee.
11. **Awards:** We will present awards for first, second and third place for each division, provided there are at least 3 bowlers in a division. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the tournament.
12. **Dress Code:** The tournament dress code will be in accordance to USBC Rule 301b. Youth participants shall not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition.
13. **Conduct:** Tournament Officials may warn or disqualify bowlers for unsportsmanlike or disruptive conduct. There will be a zero tolerance policy for foul language, rude gestures, or abuse of bowling center equipment. Tournament Officials and/or Bowling Center Management may remove any coach or spectator for disruptive conduct and if necessary, suspend them from attending future tournaments.
