## **Day 1**

### **Qualifying:**

Saturday, October 27, 2018

All bowlers will bowl one, six (6) game qualifying round moving pairs after each game. The top sixteen (16) bowlers, based on the total six (6) games bowled, will advance to the Match Play round on Sunday, October 28, 2018.

## **Day 2**

### **Match Play and Stepladder Finals:**

Sunday, October 28, 2018

Match Play begins at 10:00 am

Match Play will consist of top sixteen (16) competing in two (2) game matches. The total of both games per match will determine the winner. This will be done as double elimination match play. At the end of match play, there will be four (4) bowlers competing in the stepladder finals.

# 2018 Angie Kreitzer Memorial Queens Tournament Rules

## GENERAL

- The Greater Dayton USBC Angie Kreitzer Memorial Queens Tournament is a USBC certified event.
- All USBC rules not specified or excluded in this document are in effect.
- Courtesy to other bowlers and tournament volunteers is expected and will be enforced. Loud, rude, or unsportsmanlike behavior as defined by Tournament Officials will not be tolerated
- Unofficial tournament standings, official tournament rules and final prize lists will be available on the Greater Dayton USBC website ([www.daytonbowler.com](http://www.daytonbowler.com))

## DRESS CODE

- **All bowlers are required to wear suitable attire. SKIRTS (fingertip length), or SLACKS are preferred. JEANS, COLORED JEANS, SHORT SHIRTS, LOW RIDING BOTTOMS, SWEAT PANTS OR LEGGINGS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. ALL SLEEVELESS TOPS MUST HAVE COLLARS. NON-MEDICAL HEADGEAR AND/OR NECKWEAR (iPods, earphones, hats, cell phone accessories, etc.) WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. One verbal warning will be given. Second infraction will result in immediate disqualification. All players are requested to turn off their cell phone ringers.** Tournament committee reserves the right to deem attire unacceptable.

## ELIGIBILITY

- This is an individual tournament conducted on a SCRATCH basis. The tournament is open only to female members of the GDUSBC in good standing who have a GDUSBC book average of 170 or higher in a GDUSBC certified league for the 2017-18 season or has a current average of 170 or higher in a GDUSBC league of 15 or more games as of October 26, 2018.
- Youth meeting eligibility requirements may participate in this tournament. Any participant under the age of 18 must have written consent of her parent or guardian, and understands any tournament winnings will be presented in SMART money.
- **Adults & Youth:** If you have bowled a minimum of 21 games in a GDUSBC league in the 2017-2018 season but have not paid for your 2018-2019 local membership, you may do so prior to the start of the squad.
- All former GDUSBC members that are collegiate bowlers may participate if the \$11 membership fee is paid. (state and local fee)
- **BOWLERS MUST BE PREPARED TO SHOW PROOF OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP TO TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS PRIOR TO BOWLING.**

## ENTRY

- **Walk-ins are accepted until 9:00am on October 27, 2018.**
- **\$10.00 walk in fee.**
- No refunds will be given once paid entry has been received by GDUSBC.

## COST

- \$ 70 per entry.
- \$10 walk in fee

## PRIZE FUND

- 100% of prize fund will be returned. Top eight (8) guaranteed to cash.
- Breakdown: Lineage and expenses \$35.00 per bowler; Prize Fund: \$35.00 per bowler.

## AVERAGES

- Falsifying of average may lead to the disqualification of the bowler, forfeiture of fees, and possible suspension.
- Bowlers with an average only from a sport shot league will be readjusted based on USBC recommendations.
- All errors must be reported within 48 hours of competition. The GDUSBC phone number is 937-222-2695.

## TOURNAMENT PLAY:

- Premature termination of the tournament brought on by reasons beyond the control of the GDUSBC will result in bowlers being scheduled on the next dates available with the hosting center.
- One-lane courtesy will be given during the tournament.
- Lane Assignments – Qualifying lane assignments will be done by random draw beginning at 9:15am on Saturday, October 27th at the tournament site. Bowlers are permitted, but are not required to be present during the random lane drawing.

## Day One - Qualifying:

- Bowlers will bowl one, six (6) game qualifying round moving one pair to the right after each game. The top sixteen (16) bowlers, based on the total six (6) games bowled will advance to the Match Play Double Elimination Round.
- Tiebreaker: In the event of a tie for any position (1-16) advancing to the Match Play Double Elimination Round, the tie will be broken by using the highest game score rolled in the Qualifying Round by the bowlers tied for an advancing position.
- Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice prior to the start of the qualifying round. As participants move pairs, NO PRACTICE BALLS will be allowed.
- Bowlers arriving late will begin play and the score count beginning with the frame then being bowled. No frame may be made up. All frames missed received a zero.
- Substitutes will not be permitted.

## Day Two - Double Elimination Match Play and Stepladder Finals:

- Match Play – The top qualifier (number 1 seed) will compete against the lowest qualifier (number 16 seed). The second qualifier (number 2 seed) will compete against the next-to-lowest qualifier (number 15 seed), etc. Only one contestant will be assigned to a lane. The order of bowling will be according to the match game procedure with the bowler on the odd lane starting the match. High seed from Qualifying round will select her starting lane. The second game will be started on the lane where the 10<sup>th</sup> frame was bowled.
- Stepladder Format – There will be four (4) bowlers remaining – two (2) from the winner's bracket and two (2) from the loser's bracket. The bowler in the 4<sup>th</sup> position shall bowl the bowler in the 3<sup>rd</sup> position, with the winner of the match to bowl the 2<sup>nd</sup> seed, etc.. These shall be one game matches. Should the winner's bracket (number one seed) lose her match, another complete game will be rolled as she will only have lost one match.
- Ties: Match Play – A complete 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame shall be rolled. Higher seed picks starting lane. Stepladder – An immediate one game roll off shall be rolled. Higher seed picks starting lane.
- Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice prior to the start of the match play round. As participants move pairs, ONE PRACTICE BALL ON EACH LANE will be allowed. There will be ONE PRACTICE BALL ON EACH LANE allowed before the final round.

- Champion will receive a **PAID ENTRY** into the 2019 Ohio State USBC Queens Tournament.
- Altering the surface of a bowling ball by the use of abrasives while bowling in USBC competition is prohibited. (Rule 18) If this rule is violated, ball must be removed from competition.
- Appeals may be made, in writing, to the GDUSBC within 72 hours of the end of the final squad in the tournament.
- Decisions of the tournament committee are final.
