

Senior Men All-City Team Criteria

The GDBA Senior All-City Team's purpose is to recognize, each year from July 1st to June 30th, the top accomplishments within the USBC certified Dayton area leagues and Senior events. Points are awarded for the following categories: Averages (minimum 60 games), Honor Scores (maximum 10 points per house), and Tournaments (City Mixed, City Regular, State Championship, USBC Open(Nationals) and City Senior Tournament). You must have 60 games bowled in a GDBA certified league to be eligible for consideration.

The senior all city team will be made up of any individual over 50 years of age, or who turn 50 during the bowling season and prior to the Senior tournament, and must include one super senior, classified as anyone 60 or over or who turns 60 during the bowling season and prior to the Senior tournament. We will be honoring 5 individuals.

Honor Scores

Honor scores will be recognized per GDUSBC bowling centers with the opportunity to earn a maximum of 6 points for 300 games, a maximum of 10 total points for 800 series, and a maximum total of 16 points per center in one season. Honor scores during the Mixed, City, City Senior, State and USBC Open (Nationals) are in addition to the above points. **If you roll more than one score in a house you will earn the next available points.**

Amount of points possible per house is as follows :

300 Games – 1st 300 = 3 points; 2nd 300 = 2 points; 3rd 300 = 1 point; 4 or more = 0 points due to the cap of 6 points maximum for 300 games.

800 series – 1st 800 = 4 points; 2nd 800 = 3 points; 3rd 800 = 2 points; 4th 800 = 1 point; 5 or more = 0 points due to the cap of 10 points maximum for 800 series.

For USBC Certified Sport Shot Leagues an 800 series would be worth 8 points and 300 games would be worth 6 points. The maximum point total per house for award scores will still be 16 points.

Any combination of the above can be added together but the maximum points allowed per house is 16.

Examples per center:

3 – 300 games, 0 – 800 series = 6 points (3 + 2 + 1)

2 – 300 games, 1 – 800 series = 9 points (3 + 2 + 4)

3 – 300 games, 2 – 800 series = 13 points (3 + 2 + 1 + 4 + 3)

1 – 300 game, 4 – 800 series = 13 points (3 + 4 + 3 + 2 + 1 = 13)

You can earn up to a maximum of 26 points for averages. Averages are based on a minimum of **60** games. You can only get points once per center and your highest point value will be used. Traveling Leagues will be treated as a center.

Men's All-City Team Criteria

The GDUSBC Men's All-City Team's purpose is to recognize, each year from July 1st to June 30th, the top accomplishments within the USBC certified Dayton area leagues and events, USBC State Championships, and USBC Open (Nationals) Championships. Points are awarded for the following categories: Averages (minimum 60 games), Honor Scores, and Tournaments (City Mixed, City Regular, State Championship and USBC Open(Nationals)). You must have 60 games bowled in a GDUSBC certified league to be eligible for consideration.

Honor Scores

Honor scores will be recognized per GDUSBC bowling centers with the opportunity to earn a maximum of 6 points for 300 games, a maximum of 10 total points for 800 series, and a maximum total of 16 points per center in one season. Honor scores during the Mixed, City, State and USBC Open (Nationals) are in addition to the above points. **If you roll more than one score in a house you will earn the next available points.**

Amount of points possible per house is as follows :

300 Games – 1st 300 = 3 points; 2nd 300 = 2 points; 3rd 300 = 1 point; 4 or more = 0 points due to the cap of 6 points maximum for 300 games.

800 series – 1st 800 = 4 points; 2nd 800 = 3 points; 3rd 800 = 2 points; 4th 800 = 1 point; 5 or more = 0 points due to the cap of 10 points maximum for 800 series.

For USBC Certified Sport Shot Leagues an 800 series would be worth 8 points and 300 games would be worth 6 points. The maximum point total per house for award scores will still be 16 points.

Any combination of the above can be added together but the maximum points allowed per house is 16.

Examples per center:

3 – 300 games, 0 – 800 series = 6 points (3 + 2 + 1)

2 – 300 games, 1 – 800 series = 9 points (3 + 2 + 4)

3 – 300 games, 2 – 800 series = 13 points (3 + 2 + 1 + 4 + 3)

1 – 300 game, 4 – 800 series = 13 points (3 + 4 + 3 + 2 + 1 = 13)

Women's All-City Team Criteria

The GDUSBC Women's All-City Team's purpose is to recognize, each year from July 1st to June 30th, the top accomplishments within the USBC certified Dayton area leagues and events, USBC State Championships, and USBC Women's Championship (Nationals). Points are awarded for the following categories: Averages (minimum 60 games), Honor Scores, and Tournaments (City Mixed, Women's City Tournament, Angie Kreitzer Queen's, USBC Women's State Championship, State Queen's and USBC Women's Championship (Nationals). You must have 60 games bowled in a GDUSBC certified league to be eligible for consideration.

High Scores

High scores will be recognized per GDUSBC bowling centers (Traveling Leagues will be treated as a separate center) with the opportunity to earn a maximum of 10 points for high games, a maximum of 16 points for high series, and a maximum total of 16 points per center in one season. High scores during the Mixed, City, State and USBC Open (Nationals) are in addition to the above points. **If you roll more than one score in a center you will earn the next available points per ranking.**

Amount of game points possible per center is as follows :

300 Games – 1st = 4 points; 2nd = 3 points; 3rd = 2 points; 4th = 1 point

297-299 Games - 1st = 3 points; 2nd = 2 points; 3rd = 1 point

290-296 Games - 1st = 2 points; 2nd = 1 point

275-289 Games - 1st = 1 point

1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th high games are ranked in order to assess points. For example 2 - 300 games would = 7 points (4 + 3), but 1 - 300 and 1 - 298 would be 6 points (4 + 2) as the 298 would be considered the 2nd high game in the center.

High game points have a 10 point maximum per center during league play.

800 series – 1st = 6 points; 2nd = 4 points; 3rd = 3 points; 4th = 2 points; 5th = 1 point

775-799 series - 1st = 4 points; 2nd = 3 points; 3rd = 2 points; 4th = 1 point

750-774 series - 1st = 3 points; 2nd = 2 points; 3rd = 1 point

725-749 series - 1st = 2 points; 2nd = 1 point

700-724 series - 1st = 1 point

1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th high series are ranked in order to assess points. For example 2 - 800 series would = 10 points (6 + 4), but 1 - 800 and 1 - 775-799 would be 9 points (6 + 3) as the 775-799 would be considered the 2nd high series in the center.

High series points have a 16 point maximum per center during league play.

For USBC Certified Sport Shot Leagues high games and high series are doubled. The maximum point total per house for award scores will still be 16 points.

Examples per center:

3 – 300 games, 0 – 800 series = 9 points (4 + 3 + 2)

2 – 300 games, 1 – 800 series = 13 points (4 + 3 + 6)

1 – 300 game, 2 – 800 series = 14 points (4 + 6 + 4)

1 – 300 game, 1 - 298 game, 1 – 800 series, 1 - 775-799 series = 15 points (4 + 2 + 6 + 3)

1 - 300 game, 1 - 299 game, 1 - 775-799 series, 1 - 725-749 series = 11 points (4+2+4+1)

1 - 299 game, 1 - 290-296 game, 1 - 750-774 series, 1 - 700-724 series = 8 points (3 + 1 + 4 + 0)
