

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement

In order to be in compliance with Northwest Indiana Soccer League (NWISL) Policy 113, each parent/guardian that has a player who participates in the Michigan City Soccer Club (MCSC) Rec Plus League will be required to sign and abide by this “Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement.” This agreement must be signed before a player will be eligible to play in any NWISL game for the Michigan City Soccer Club. By signing this agreement, you agree to conduct yourself appropriately. There will be no exceptions to this requirement.

I/We agree to:

- Be a positive example for my player and avoid criticism
- Make my players athletic participation a positive experience, both for them and other participants as well
- Accept the decisions of the officials with good grace
- Be generous when my team wins
- Be graceful when my team loses
- Conduct myself with honor and dignity
- Not engage in physical or verbal confrontations with spectators, officials, coaches, or players
- Never encourage or accept the intentional injury of a player
- Support the coach and coaching staff
- Never confront a coach. If I have a question of a coach, I will contact him or her at a later time
- Never bring or use alcohol at a game

In addition, as a parent/guardian of a player of a Michigan City Soccer Club Rec Plus team, I have read the “Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement” for the Rec Plus teams and agree to abide by those rules and regulations.
