

Player Code of Conduct Agreement

In order to be in compliance with Northwest Indiana Soccer League (NWISL) Policy 113, each player that plays for the Michigan City Soccer Club (MCSC) Rec Plus League will be required to sign and abide by this “Players Code of Conduct Agreement.” This agreement must be signed before a player will be eligible to play in any NWISL game for the Michigan City Soccer Club. By signing this agreement, you agree to conduct yourself appropriately. There will be no exceptions to this requirement.

- Be graceful when my team loses
- Always play fair, no matter what the cost
- Obey the laws of the game
- Work for the good of my team
- Accept the decisions of the officials with good grace
- Believe in the honesty of my opponents

- Not engage in physical or verbal confrontations with spectators, officials, coaches, or other players
- Do my best to make sure my teammates adhere to the above rules as well
